

# Am I Eligible to Apply for Graduation?

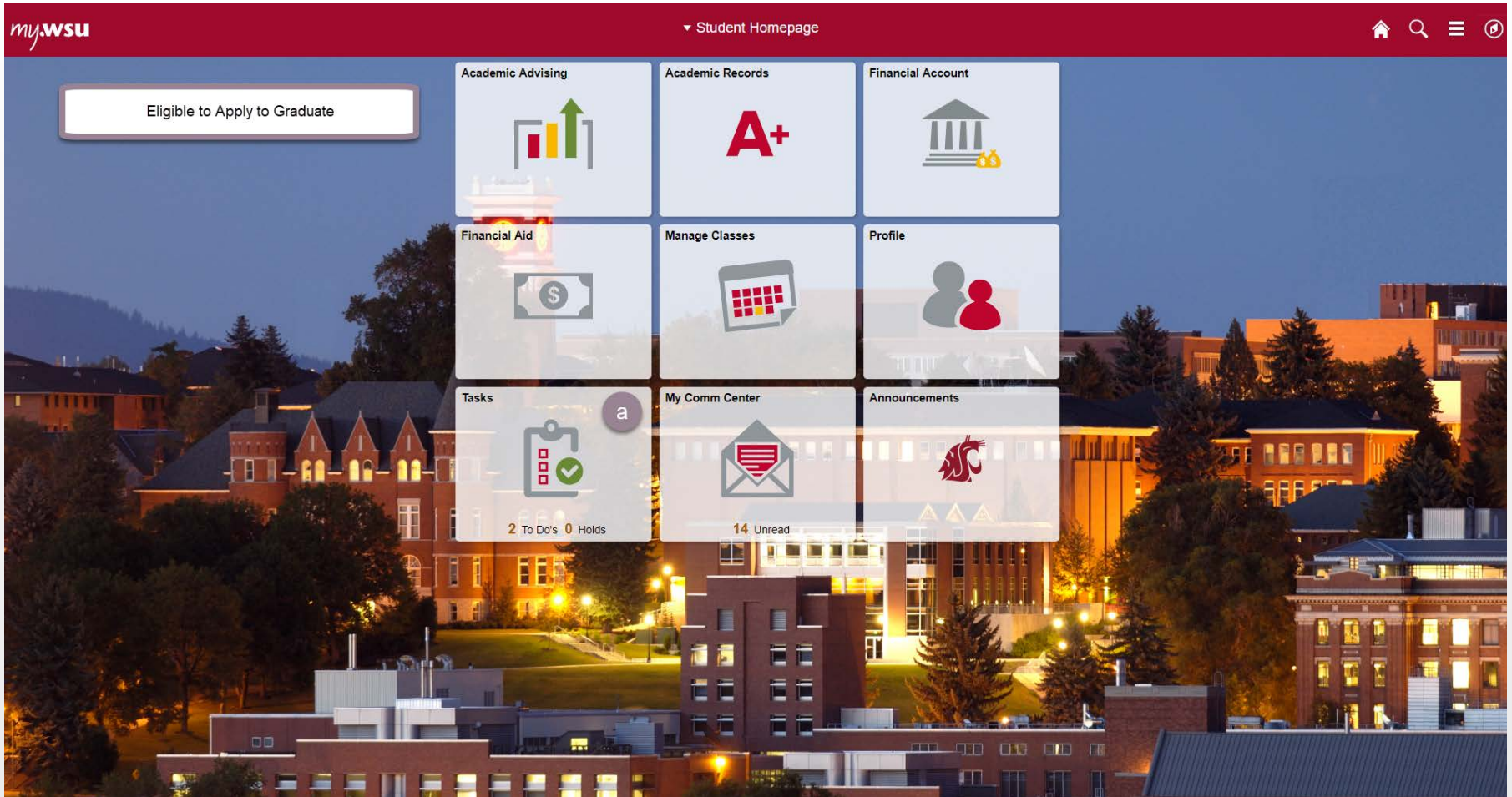
